The museum uses WhistleTix to sell online tickets for the Dinner Trains, Picnic Trains and Special Event Trains, such as our annual Christmas Trains and Bunny Trains. This speeds the ticketing process, allows reservations months in advance, and allows travelers to print out tickets at home.

Reservations are required for Dinner Trains, Beer Tasting Trains, Bunny Trains and Christmas Trains, which often sell out in advance.

We do not take advanced reservations for our regular weekend train rides.



Statistics and Improvements

2018 Ridership Statistics

- 13,567 regular fare tickets were sold
- 1,557 meals were served on the Dinner Trains, Picnic Trains and Special Trains
- 1,808 people hopped aboard our Bunny Trains
- 5,378 people rode our Christmas Trains
- Overall ridership was 24,686.

Track Maintenance and Improvements

- The ETRM maintains 7.5 miles of track between East Troy and Mukwonago
- Over 1,000 ties were replaced in 2018 and the track was tamped and leveled
- Brush was cut along the line to improve views for riders and to offer better visibility

New Boarding Platforms

- We are working to install new boarding platforms in East Troy and at Town Hall Park and Indianhead Park in Mukwonago. The new platforms in Mukwonago will make boarding and departing the trains easier in those locations.

Milwaukee Streetcar #846

- Car 846 is one of only five existing Milwaukee streetcars, and one of only two that still operate. In 2017 we had the trucks on the car rebuilt, and new wheels were installed, allowing the streetcar to return to the rails for many more years.
